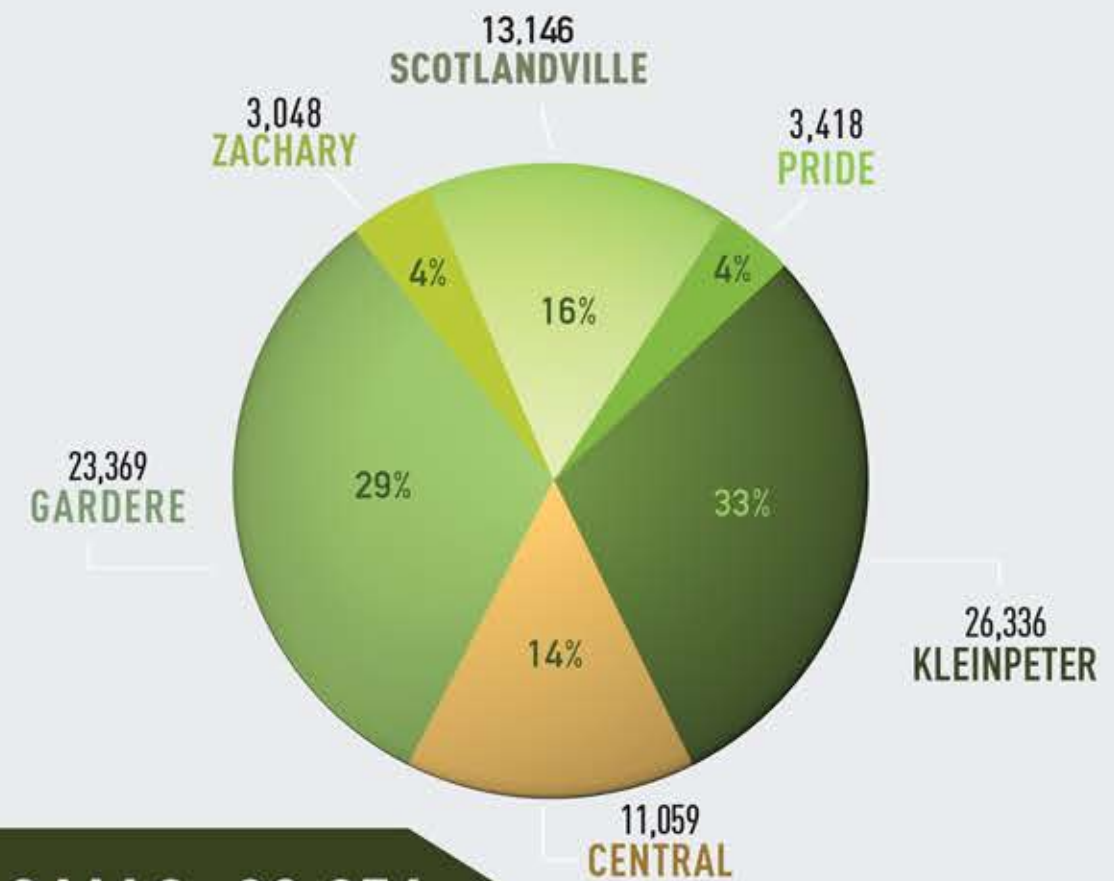

### FLEET OPERATIONS

In an effort to save the agency money, EBRSO Fleet Operations services it's own vehicles when possible. In 2018, Fleet Operations completed **3,067 mechanical repairs** and washed numerous units in-house, including other agency vehicles. Fleet Operations personnel had **96 equipment moves** for 2018.

RALI (Radios, Accessories, Lights and Installations) completed **66 installations on new units**, repaired units and programmed radios including other agency vehicles and radios. RALI also conducted an additional **441 miscellaneous repairs** to EBRSO units and other agency units. They also were able to install **29 in-car camera systems**.

### GRANTS

Managed approximately **\$878,706.00**, in Homeland Security (Port Security) Grant funds, and **\$2,275,967.00**, in other grant funds which includes grants from The Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement (LCLE), The Louisiana Highway Safety Commission (LHSC), and the US Dept. of Justice (USDOJ), COPS Hiring Program - for a total of **\$3,154,673.00**. We have expended (used/spent) **\$2,630,738.55** of that amount.
